**Frequent Flyers Ultralight Club** was started in December 2002 by Tim Pierce and Tim Wall. Pierce, who lives in Hillsboro, flew a Quicksilver Sport and Wall, from Henniker, a Quicksilver Sprint. Wall had been flying for about 3 years when Pierce arrived at Hawthorne as a student pilot. Wall mentored Pierce through his first solo in August 2001. After a trip to Sun & Fun and many hours of short trips they decided to form a club to gather other ultralight pilots and promote flying to non pilots. The club meets at Hawthorne Feather Airport (8B1) the first Sunday of

every month at 10:00am. Everyone is welcome to attend and the club is looking for new members. Hawthorne is a small privately owned airport with a 3200 foot paved runway. The hangar is home to 12 to 15 aircraft. Several more aircraft can be found in the tiedown area on the ramp. There is a self serve fuel system available 24/7 to anyone with a credit card. The CTAF is 122.8 and the airport has pilot controlled lighting. Jim Rymes, owner, and the pilots based at 8B1 are friendly and a valuable source of information to pilots new to flying or the area.
