We then flew over to Henniker where John demonstrated some aerobatics and then back to Hawthorne. The cameraman set up his tripod and taped some shots of John and Rand flying in formation. The Stearman is a 2 seat bi plane that was used during WWII for instruction. Many fighter pilots received their initial flight training in the Stearman. It is a thrill to fly in the open cockpit and experience a part of history.
